School Teaching Experience

As a credentialed music teacher, Linda has taught an estimated 1,600 students from pre-school to grade 12 in San Diego and Nashville-area schools. She has been honored to host many recitals, musicals, choral performances, recorder, guitar, xylophone, and drum ensembles of over 100 children at a time in her employment with school districts. She has developed the following curricula for the following K-12 courses to date: Children's Choir, Class Drumming, Musical Theater Crash Course Performance, High School Musical Theater, Class Piano Lab, Class Guitar, Children's Choir, High School SSAA, SATB, and Show Choir, High School Barbershop Quartet, Recorder Karate, Music Street Solfegge Instruction Grades K-3, Music Composition, Music Appreciation, Music Theory, and Build Your Own Instrument.
